

FOCUS ON: BLACKHEAD COASTAL PATH

The upper path, promenade, upper light house path and path below the cliff face remain closed to the general public.

Works on the section C path are currently ongoing. Wooden step treads for existing steps have been installed with installation of the new timber handrail currently in progress. Path repairs and vegetation cut back where it has encroached on the path, have been completed on the remainder of the path. The new metal handrails are ongoing.

Works is completed on the cliff face repairs.

Works on the section B path are currently ongoing with scaffolding installed to enable repairs on the bridge at the gully. Path repair works have also commenced.
