

Health and Safety Policy Statement

(In particular the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations and the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act.)

The Company wishes to draw the attention of everyone concerned to their duty under the relevant legislation to take all reasonable care for the Health and Safety of themselves and all others who may be affected by their acts, or omissions at work. Managers and supervisors with direct responsibility for the Company's sites and premises are expected to personally conduct frequent safety visits to assess working practices and equipment.

Operational Managers and supervisors, supported by the, Safety, Health and Environmental (SHE) manager/s and safety representatives, will communicate the Company's Health & Safety Policy to their staff. Employees will be consulted on health and safety matters and will be involved in the formulation of health and safety procedures.


All company vehicles must be used in accordance with the rules, regulations and guidelines as referred to in the "Fleet Drivers Handbook" which has been issued to all drivers.
